

PRIVACY AND COOKIE NOTICE

This website ("**the Site**") is operated by Teva Branded Pharmaceutical Products R&D Inc. ("Teva"). Teva is referred to in this privacy notice as "we", "us" and "our." Please visit <http://www.tevapharm.com> for more information about Teva.

Scope of this Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice applies to personal data we collect through the Site. It describes how we use your data and your data protection rights, including a right to object to some of the processing which we carry out. More information about your rights, and how to exercise them, is set out in the "How we store your information and your rights" section.

Our Site may include links to other websites over which we have no control. Teva is not responsible for the privacy policies or practices of other websites. We may also link to other websites operated by Teva or Teva's affiliated companies which operate under separate privacy policies. If you access these websites via our Site, you should review the privacy policies of those sites so you can understand how they collect, use and share your information.

The Data We Collect

We collect the information which you have provided directly to us on this Site. For researchers, this may include your name, title and other professional information, contact information, and the information contained in your CV. For the public or trial participants, this may include your name and contact information.

In addition, this Site collects certain identifying and activity information automatically, such as your device type, Internet Protocol (IP) address, device and advertising identifiers, operating system, Internet service provider, the date and time of your website use, information about the links you click and your other interactions with the website, and other standard log information. We also may receive error-reporting information in the event of a technical error, including the device type and version, device identifiers, the time the error occurred, the feature being used, the state of the website when the error occurred, and any communications or content provided at the time the error occurred.

How we use your information

We process the personal data described above for the following purposes:

- To attend to your request (information on trials, access to research)
- To place cookies and similar technologies, as described below
- To allow us to pursue our legitimate business interests, in particular to:
- Analyse the use of our Site in order to continuously improve content and measure performance and to provide technical support and trouble-shooting
- Optimize and tailor the use of our Site and our communication to you
- Improve our products and services
- To meet legal, and compliance requirements, in particular to respond to requests for information from government authorities.

Sharing your personal data

Teva may disclose your personal data to the following categories of recipients (in all cases, only when necessary to fulfil their functions):

- Our staff (including employees and external consultants), professional advisors and agents;
- Third party service providers which process your personal data on behalf of Teva and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep your personal data confidential and appropriately secure, such as TrialScope.
- Government authorities, regulatory agencies and law enforcement officials, if required for the purposes specified above, if mandated by law, or if required for the legal protection of our legitimate interests in compliance with applicable laws;
- If there is a corporate sale, merger, reorganisation, insolvency event or other similar event.

Cookies and related tracking technologies

Use of Cookies on the Site

Teva uses cookies to collect information about you and store your online preferences. Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the website when you return to it: this is useful because it allows the website to recognise your device. Teva uses the following categories of cookies on the Site:

Category 1: Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the Site and use its features. Without these cookies, services you have asked for (such as remembering your login details) cannot be provided.

Category 2: Performance Cookies

These cookies collect information on how people use the Site. For example, we use these cookies to help us understand how customers arrive at the Site, browse or use the Site and highlight areas where we can improve such as navigation, user experience and marketing campaigns. The data collected is only used to improve how the Site works. For example we use Google Analytics to better understand how customers use the Site. Category 3: Functionality Cookies

These cookies remember choices you make (such as language choices). You may also have rights to object to some processing. These rights may be limited in some situations – for example, where we can demonstrate we have a legal requirement to process your personal data.
